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## Welcome to George

We want you to have a stress-free adventure, so please take a few moments to read through the manual and familiarize yourself with its workings.

George does like to let out the odd groan or 2, between gear changes! don't worry he's done this all his life, it's just his way 😊

We appreciate accidents may happen, however if any contents are lost or damaged please highlight this when you return the van (please see terms & conditions for damages). This will ensure the items can be replaced ready for the next set of adventurers.

All cupboards are numbered and labelled inside with their contents. An inventory check list will be completed upon Georges return

Please find complimentary Olive Oil, tea, coffee, sugar and that all important **complimentary bottle of Fizz** in the fridge to set you off on your adventures!!(Please drink responsibly).

We also supply washing up liquid, anti-bacterial cleaning spray, dish cloth, sponge, bin bags cling film, kitchen roll, hand soap, tea towel

**FIRST AID KIT – LOCATED IN GLOVE COMPARTMENT.**

### Important legal info.

**T5 legal Speed limits in the UK.**

**Single carriageways – 50mph.**

**Dual carriageways – 60mph.**

**Motorways – 70mph.**

### Pitch up

Levelling ramps –Located in cupboard 6 required, spirit level is in glove box.

Privacy screen – Located in rear, fits externally onto cab. **ENSURE ROOF IS UP BEFORE APPLYING PRIVACY SCREEN. REMOVE PRIVACY SCREEN BEFORE LOWERING ROOF.**

Hook Up–You will find your 10m mains hook up lead in rear cupboard.

The T5 Hook up point is located under the driver's side rear bumper –Remove the cap to use and replace after use.

### Main Control panel

Located to the right of the sink, to use, press the on button.

There are 2 battery charge indicators L– for leisure battery V – vehicle battery. Please use leisure battery setting. The leisure battery also gets charged whilst engine is running/when you're travelling

To switch on under worktop LED lighting press light switch.

To operate the water, tap on the sink first press the water tap button. Then lift tap neck to upright position. **THE TAP DOES NOT SWIVEL.**

### POP UP ROOF INSTRUCTIONS

Before putting the roof up and down ensure a door/window is left open to allow airflow in/out.

Remove the fabric straps from storage location. Hold the buckles, feed the straps through to loosen, leave approx. 6" before end of strap on both sides.

Push roof gently upwards, while holding on to the straps. Once roof is in fully opened position, take up the tension in the straps. The ceiling can now be pushed up into the roof.

### Bedtime

Ensure roof side vents are closed, (they get trapped in ceiling). Pull van ceiling down, ensure passenger chair is facing inwards, this provides the platform to access the bed area. The windows in the roof can be opened for ventilation.

**PLEASE DO NOT STAND ON CHAIR ARMRESTS – THEY ARE NOT DESIGNED TO TAKE WEIGHT.**

### To close Pop up roof ready for travel

Remove duvet & pillows.

Ensure roof side vents are closed.

Ensure privacy screen has been removed.

Pull ceiling down into position.

Open a door/window to allow air flow.

Pulling both strap ends together, gently pull the roof back down through the buckles, ensuring canvas sides bellow inwards (this will ensure sides won't get trapped in roof brackets).

**PLEASE ENSURE ALL THE STRAP LENGTH HAS BEEN PULLED THROUGH THE BUCKLES, IS PULLED TIGHT AND THE ROOF IS SECURED INTO POSITION. (THE STRAPS CAN GET FOLDED UP IN THE FABRIC & THE ROOF WILL LIFT WHEN YOU'RE DRIVING).**

ROLL STRAPS UP AND TUCK IN.

### Heating control panel

To start the heater, press the bottom right hand button and it will run for 1 hour, press centre home button to increase up to 8 hours -to adjust temperature use up and down arrows. Please see pg8 for the manufactures heating manual. The heater runs off diesel from the main tank

## Internal lighting

Switch for internal lighting is located at the bottom of the pillar behind the passenger seat.

The downlights can then be individually controlled by touching the outer rim.

The switch for the pop up bedroom is located at the top of same pillar.

## USB Points

2 Located under the control panel.

2 Located in the pop up bedroom in left hand corner.

## Kitchen

**Cupboard 1 & 5** –For personal use, bin bags, cling film & Kitchen roll

**Cupboard 2** –Pots, pans & olive oil –Bottom left of the fridge –**PLEASE REMOVE BLUE DISCS IN PANS BEFORE COOKING. REPLACE AFTER USE.**

**Cupboard 3** – Blue cupboard under the sink, crockery

**Cupboard 4** – Blue cupboard above the work surface, glasses, cleaning products, tea, coffee, sugar & blue tooth speaker. Tea Towel (hook for the tea towel above fridge)

**Drawer 1** – Blue drawer above crockery cupboard, cooking Utensils.

**Drawer 2** – Blue drawer under lift work top, cutlery.

**Gas Hob** – **ENSURE WINDOW IS OPEN SLIGHTLY WHILE COOKING** –Ensure gas is turned on. Gas is in gas locker under bed, accessed from the rear.

To ignite the rings, turn applicable knob for each ring on the hob and press the ignitor.

**ENSURE ALL GAS TURNED OFF AFTER USE. ISOLATE THE GAS BOTTLE BEFORE TRAVELLING.**

**Sink** (cold water tap only)–2 x 10L fresh water containers are in the cupboard under the sink.

To access the water containers, lift work top and pull drawer forward.

Please see control panel instructions for water instructions.

When on site **please place collapsible bucket (found in rear cupboard) under external wastepipe to collect waste.** Please empty at campsites wastewater disposal point & rinse & dry bucket after use

**Fridge** – includes fridge thermometer & 1 bag of ice cubes in freezer compartment.

The fridge works off mains and battery. To switch the fridge on ensure the main control panel is switched on. Inside the fridge, you will find the on/off button. Press and hold to switch fridge on.

To adjust the temperature, press the thermometer button to move light down. The closer to the thermometer button the light gets, the colder the fridge will become. There is a digital thermometer in the fridge so you can keep an eye on the temperature.

## Rear Storage

**Cupboard 7**–Grey large sliding door cupboard, for personal use.

**Cupboard 8** –Small blue cupboard – table leg, mains lead, mallet, pegs for awning, blue roll & interior rug for use in the living area for cosy feet.

**Large opening** – rechargeable lamp /privacy screen /dish drainer/ collapsible bucket / basket – ideal for taking pots to washing up facilities

Self-inflating mattress for RIB BED / outdoor chair storage X 4.

**2 x 35 litre storage boxes** for personal use, please use one for footwear as this can easily be cleaned.

**PLEASE DON'T PUT FOOTWEAR IN ANY OTHER CUPBOARDS.**

**1 x 9 litre storage box** –camping accessories &  **for that girly touch.**

Jack and wheel brace is located on the rear left wheel arch.

**Awning handle.** – located along the rear top cupboard. **ONCE AWINING IS ERECTED PLEASE RETURN THE HANDLE TO ITS STORAGE POSITION (SO IT DOESN'T SCRATCH THE PAINT WORK).**

## Sundries

**Map** – passenger door pocket.

**Mirror** –located on the inside of cupboard 5 above rear seats

**Bluetooth speaker** –located in cupboard 4.

**Table** –Table Top Located behind the driver's seat. Table leg is in rear small blue cupboard. Base is in rear opening. This table can be safely used outside. (please don't leave it outside in bad weather conditions)

**Drawer 3 under bed**–for personal use.

**Cupboard 6- Porta pottie** –Located in left hand cupboard under seat. Tablets & gloves in Box 1

To use pottie. Remove from cupboard, open the lid and complete ablution's!! Pull handle out at front of posttie to open waste chute. To flush, raise & lower rear left hand plunger.

To Empty –move white switch at rear of pottie across. Lift top section. Take bottom grey section to empty at the campsites chemical disposal.

At chemical disposal rotate grey curved arm, unscrew white lid to allow air in to flush fluid out, push white button and empty, ensure thorough rinsing before returning to the van

**THIS MUST BE EMPTIED & CLEANED BEFORE RETURNING OR A SURCHARGE WILL BE LEVIED.**

## RIB Bed

To extend bed –Pull handle to the right of the seat, whilst holding, put your hand down the back of the seat, pull seat upwards, keeping hold of the handle until level.

To lower seat back pull bar upwards and seat back downwards – press into place.

Then roll out self-inflating mattress on top. Unscrew the 2 x black valve caps to allow air in **DO NOT INFLATE THE MATTRESS**. Once inflated, tighten the valve caps. Before rolling back up, unscrew valve caps, then roll matters up ensuring all the air is pushed out. Then tighten valve caps once again .....sweet dreams!!

**Bedding packs** –if ordered are in vacuumed sealed packs in rear, on the top of the bed.

## SEATS

To swivel both front seats.

Ensure the seat is at full height using the lever on the door side of the seat (pump up).

**Passenger seat** –Bring seat back upright, put the arm rest down, slide the seat all the way forward using handle at the front of seat. Then push red leaver forward while turning the seat clockwise.

**Drives seat** –Ensure steering wheel is in its highest position, bring the seat back upright, put the arm rests down. Slide seat all the way forward using handle at the front, hold the red leaver whilst rotating anticlockwise. Push seat back once rotated.

## Awning –ensure sliding & passenger doors are closed.

Using the awning handle located in the rear, put the hook into the eye located to the rear of the awning, holding the handle in one hand rotate with the other until canopy rolls out to approx. 4ft/1m.

Then release both legs located at the leading edge of the canopy.

Drop the legs down and adjust to height using butterfly nuts, to take the weight of the canopy.

Then continue extending the canopy.

Adjust leg height & position as necessary. If raining ensure one leg sits shorter than other to allow the rain to run off.

**Once awning fully extended remove handle. Ensure the leg at the front of the van is high enough to be able to open the passenger door with clearance. Ensure legs are pegged down.**

**PEGS ARE IN THE PEG/MALLET BAG IN CUPBOARD 8 TO SECURE LEGS TO GROUND.DO NOT LEAVE THE AWNING OUT IF VEHICLE IS UNATTEND, OVERNIGHT OR IN HIGH WINDS.**
