Your Privacy

This policy explains how we might collect and use personal information and the rights and choices available to our visitors and users regarding such information. What type of information do we collect?

How do we collect information?

Why do we collect such personal information?

We collect such Non-personal and Personal Information for the following purposes:

- 1. To provide and operate the services.
- 2. To provide our Users with ongoing customer assistance and technical support.
- 3. To be able to contact our Visitors and Users with general or personalized service-related notices and promotional messages.
- 4. To create aggregated statistical data and other aggregated and/or inferred Non-personal Information, which we or our business partners may use to provide and improve our respective services.
- 5. To comply with any applicable laws and regulations.

How do we store, use, share and disclose our site visitors' personal information?

The AJ Adventures website is hosted on the **Wix.com** platform. Wix.com provides us with the online platform that allows us to sell our products and services to you. Your data may be stored through Wix.com's data storage, databases and the general Wix.com applications. They store your data on secure servers behind a firewall. Wix.com also regularly monitors their systems for possible vulnerabilities and attacks, and regularly seeks new ways and Third Party Services for further enhancing the security of their Services and protection of their Visitors' and Users' privacy.

All direct payment gateways offered by Wix.com and used by our company adhere to the standards set by PCI-DSS as managed by the PCI Security Standards Council, which is a joint effort of brands like Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Discover. PCI-DSS requirements help ensure the secure handling of credit card information by our store and its service providers.
